A reading from the Epistle of Saint Paul to the Galatians (2:16-21)

Brethren, we know man is not justified by the works of the Law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. Hence we also believe in Christ Jesus, that we may be justified by faith in Christ, and not by the works of the Law, because by the works of the Law no man will be justified. But if, while we are seeking to be justified in Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, is Christ therefore the minister of sin? By no means. For if I rebuild the things I destroyed, I make myself a sinner. For through the Law I have died to the Law that I may live for God. With Christ I am nailed to the cross. It is now no longer I who live, but Christ is living in me. And the life I now live in the flesh, I live within the faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave himself up for me.

الرسالة (غلاطية 2: 16-20)

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Sant Mark the Evangelist (8:34-38; 9:1)

The Lord said, “If anyone wishes to come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. For anyone who would save his life will lose it; but anyone who loses his life for my sake and for the sake of the Good News will save it. For what does it profit a man, if he gains the whole world, but suffers the loss of his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul? For whoever is ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him will the Son of Man also be ashamed when he comes with the holy angels in the glory of his Father.” And he said to them, “Amen I say to you, there are some of those standing here who will not taste death, till they have seen the kingdom of God coming in power.”

GOSPEL REFLEXION

In today's Gospel reading from Mark 8:34-9:1, Jesus gives us a profound and challenging message about discipleship. He says to the crowd and His disciples, "**Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves, take up their cross, and follow me.**" These words are not easy to hear, but they are at the heart of what it means to follow Christ.

To deny oneself means letting go of our selfish desires, ambitions, and the pursuit of comfort. Jesus calls us to live not for ourselves but for Him, placing God's will above our own. This is a radical shift from the values of the world, which often encourage us to seek personal success, power, and comfort. Instead, Jesus asks us to embrace humility and selflessness, reminding us that true fulfillment is found not in accumulating things but in surrendering our lives to God.

Taking up our cross is another powerful image. In Jesus' time, the cross was a symbol of suffering and death. When Jesus tells us to take up our cross, He is inviting us to accept the difficulties, sacrifices, and hardships that come with being His disciple. Following Jesus does not mean that life will be easy or free from pain, but it does mean that He will be with us in our suffering, giving us the strength to endure and the hope of eternal life.


Jesus then asks, "**What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul?**" This question challenges us to reflect on what we value most in life. It is easy to get caught up in the pursuit of wealth, status, or approval from others, but Jesus reminds us that these things are temporary. Our soul -our relationship with God- is what truly matters. If we focus only on the things of this world, we risk losing the eternal life that Jesus offers us.

In the final verse of this passage, Jesus makes a promise: "**Truly I tell you, some who are standing here will not taste death before they see that the kingdom of God has come with power.**" This is a message of hope. The Kingdom of God is not a distant dream; it is already breaking into the world through Jesus. When we follow Christ, we begin to experience the joy, peace, and love of God's Kingdom, even in the midst of life's struggles.

As we reflect on this Gospel, let us remember that being a disciple of Jesus requires sacrifice, but it also leads to true freedom and eternal life.

When we deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow Christ, we are walking the path that leads to the fullness of life with God.

Let us ask for the grace to follow Him faithfully, no matter the cost.




Lectura de la Carta de San Pablo a los Gálatas (2:16-20)

Hermanos: como sabemos que el hombre no es justificado por las obras de la Ley, sino por la fe en Jesucristo, hemos creído en él, para ser justificados por la fe de Cristo y no por las obras de la Ley. Ahora bien, si al buscar nuestra justificación en Cristo, resulta que también nosotros somos pecadores, entonces Cristo está al servicio del pecado. Esto no puede ser, porque si me pongo a reconstruir lo que he destruido, me declaro a mí mismo transgresor de la Ley. Pero en virtud de la Ley, he muerto a la Ley, a fin de vivir para Dios. Yo estoy crucificado con Cristo, y ya no vivo yo, sino que Cristo vive en mí: la vida que sigo viviendo en la carne, la vivo en la fe en el Hijo de Dios, que me amó y se entregó por mí. Yo no anulo la gracia de Dios: si la justicia viene de la Ley, Cristo ha muerto inútilmente.

ALELUYA: Salmo 44:4, 5 & 8 (Tono 4)

Lectura del santo Evangelio según San Marcos el evangelista (8:34-38; 9:1)

Dijo el Señor: «El que quiera venir detrás de mí, que renuncie a sí mismo, que cargue con su cruz y me siga. Porque el que quiera salvar su vida, la perderá; y el que pierda su vida por mí y por la Buena Noticia, la salvará. ¿De qué le servirá al hombre ganar el mundo entero, si pierde su vida? ¿Y qué podrá dar el hombre a cambio de su vida? Porque si alguien se avergüenza de mí y de mis palabras en esta generación adúltera y pecadora, también el Hijo del hombre se avergonzará de él cuando venga en la gloria de su Padre con sus santos ángeles». Y les decía: «Les aseguro que algunos de los que están aquí presentes no morirán antes de haber visto que el Reino de Dios ha llegado con poder».
